Refund Policy:

Youth sports fees are not refundable unless the cancellation was made by BGCSTC. If your child is no longer able to participate, you must notify the coach and BGCSTC administration in writing as soon as possible. You will not be eligible for a cash refund. Instead, funds received for sport fees will be applied as a credit to your child’s account for future programs or activities. Anyone receiving a credit will have one year from date of credit issued to use it or it will be forfeited.

It is the policy of BGCSTC that the \$25.00 annual membership fee is non-refundable. Your child may access all programs and activities available to Club members for one year from your registration date. For more information on Club activities, visit www.bgcstc.org/youth-programs.

Applicable equipment deposits are returned when all equipment is turned in to BGCSTC.

Inclement Weather Policy/Acts of God

If BGCSTC is closed due to inclement weather (St. Charles Unit follows St. Charles School District and O'Fallon Unit follows the Fort-Zumwalt School District for all closings) all youth sports activities will be canceled. If a cancellation needs to be made in the evening or on a weekend, BGCSTC will notify KSDK 5 and post to BGCSTC website and social media. Practices and games cancelled due to weather will not be rescheduled and no refunds will be granted.

No-Show Policy for Games:

Since games are not rescheduled due to cancellations, it is important that each team makes the best effort to attend all games at their scheduled times. Teams will be fined \$50 for each cancelled game. If your team must cancel, please try to give BGCSTC Athletic Coordinator 24 hours' notice so all affected parties can be notified.

CODE OF CONDUCT AND ETHICS— **Keep for your Records**

Boys & Girls Clubs of St. Charles County is committed to developing young athletes physically, emotionally and socially through their participation in our athletic programs. The skills developed in these programs will serve the participants not just in their future sports endeavors, but also in every aspect of their lives. The players must be taught sportsmanship and fair play, along with the rules and skills of the game or activity, and these teachings should always govern their behavior while at practice and at games or events.

Children learn by example, thus we are dedicated to providing the best models of sportsmanship, fairness, respect, self-control, teamwork and trust within a safe environment that builds confidence and self-esteem. Parents and guardians are vital to the development of young athletes. We ask that parents and spectators model good sportsmanship and lead by example before, during and after practices, games and other events.

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AND ETHICS

- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child never feels defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- My guests and I will never ridicule or yell at my child or any other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- My guests and I will accept the decisions of officials on the field as being called to their best ability and will never question coaches at the game field.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during practices and games from the sideline, unless I am an official member of the coaching staff.
- I will provide a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at every practice, game, or event.
- Conflicts with coaches, officials, committee member or other parents will first be addressed with the team coach or BGCSTC Athletic Coordinator.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules that I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or BGCSTC Administration
- Ejection from the stands
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file
- Parental season suspension
- Player season suspension
